**ROUTES TO THE TRACKING TEST**

**From Host Hotel** – Take I 270 north for 1.2 miles, it will then become US 15 North. Take US 15 North for 36 miles to York Rd (Rt. 30). Take York Rd. (Rt. 30) west toward Gettysburg, go .4 miles. Turn right on Shealer Rd (Hampton Inn on corner). At 1.1 miles, Shealer Rd. becomes Boyd's School Road. Continue 0.8 miles to Table Rock Rd. Turn right. Go 1.5 miles to Redding Farm (on left). Drawing will be held at Redding Farm.

**From North, (Harrisburg PA)** – From the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) take US 15 South for approximately 27 miles to York Rd (Rt. 30). Follow directions above from York Rd (Rt. 30)

### AWARDS

#### DARK GREEN ROSETTE FOR ALL DOGS PASSING THE TD & TDX TESTS

**A monocular will be given for all dogs that qualify. A water bucket will be given to all entries.**

*The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.*

### GENERAL INFORMATION & TEST RULES

- 1) Eligibility - This test is for dogs that are not less than six months of age and otherwise eligible for a particular test. A dog must have a TD title in order to enter the TDX test.
- 2) Bitches in season - Bitches in season MAY participate, provided that the test secretary and judges are notified of same prior to the drawing of tracks. The last track(s) laid shall be for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a test only after all the other dogs and bitches have been tested.
- 3) **TEST LIMIT AND RANDOM DRAW:** This is a Combined TD/TDX test. The test is limited to four TD dogs and three TDX. Entries will remain open until 6:00 PM Wednesday, April 4, 2016. If entries received exceed the limit, a random draw will be held on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the home of the Test Secretary. Any interested person can attend the drawing. The draw will be done according to Ch. 1, Sec. 17b Specialty Club Options, pg 6 of Tracking Regulations. Draw 1: Belgian Sheepdogs without a title; Draw 2: Belgian Sheepdogs with a title; Draw 3: other breeds without a title; Draw 4: other breeds with a title. There will be an alternate list with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants the evening of the draw of the results by email if a valid email address has been provided or by telephone. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limits for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged at the rate of 2 TD tracks to 1 TDX track, to the maximum allowed by the AKC Tracking Regulations.
- 4) Drawing for track position - The draw for running order of the tracks for the TD and TDX tests will be held at 7:45 am on Wednesday, April 27, 2016 at Redding Farm. Judging will begin as soon after the draw as the first track is ready.
- 5) Test Hours & Rules - The tracking test hours are from 6:00 am to 5:00 pm on Monday, April 23, 2016. All AKC rules and regulations will be observed. Dogs must remain on lead and under control at all times.
- 6) Refunds - Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on

the test day unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

- 7) Please note - According to the AKC Tracking regulations, "A dog that is allowed to run free and off-lead, at any time before the test, during a test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused.". **Please keep dogs on lead and clean up after them.**
- 8) **TD's** – "A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD test. This statement must be dated within one year of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test."

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
